引言

詩篇13篇向我們展述了大衛從絕望到歡欣過程的反應。

INTRODUCTION

Psalm 13 shows us the transitioning responses of David as he moves from despair to rejoicing.

A. 絕望的呼喊 (13:1-2)

¹耶和華啊！你忘記我要到幾時呢？要到永遠嗎？你掩面不顧我，要到幾時呢？²我心裡籌算不安，內心終日愁苦，要到幾時呢？我的仇敵勝過我，要到幾時呢？

A. A Cry of Despair (13:1-2)

1 How long, O Lord? Will You forget me forever? How long will You hide Your face from me?

2 How long shall I take counsel in my soul, Having sorrow in my heart daily? How long will my enemy be exalted over me?

詩篇13篇1-2節裡三個形容絕望的向度

1. 第一個向度：在屬靈的絕望(13:1)

THREE Dimensions of Despair in Psalm
13:1-2

1. First Dimension: The despair may be spiritual
(13:1)

上帝會忘記祂的兒女嗎？

以賽亞書49:14-16

¹⁴但錫安說：“耶和華離棄了我，我的主忘記了我。”¹⁵ 婦人怎能忘記她吃奶的嬰孩，不憐憫她親生的兒子呢？即使她們可能忘記，我也不會忘記你。¹⁶看哪！我已經把你刻在我的掌上；你的城牆常常在我面前。

Will God forget His children?

Isaiah 49:14-16

14 But Zion said, “The Lord has forsaken me, And my Lord has forgotten me.” 15 “Can a woman forget her nursing child, And not have compassion on the son of her womb? Surely they may forget, Yet I will not forget you. 16 See, I have inscribed you on the palms of My hands; Your walls are continually before Me.

我們的感受：

- 感受是上帝賜予的，是在我們裡面上帝形像的一部分。
- 感受會受到我們墮落的影響，這就是為什麼我們不能相信自己的感受。

Our FEELINGS:

- They are God-given, they are part of the image of God in us.
- But they are affected by our fallenness
And that is why we cannot trust our feelings.

³ 耶和華我的上帝啊！求你看顧我，應允我；求你使我的眼睛明亮，免得我沉睡至死；⁴免得我的仇敵說：“我勝過了他”；免得我跌倒的時候我的敵人就歡呼。

B. A Cry for Help (13:3-4)

3 Consider and hear me, O Lord my God; Enlighten my eyes, Lest I sleep the sleep of death; 4 Lest my enemy say, “I have prevailed against him” ; Lest those who trouble me rejoice when I am moved.

1. David desperately cries out to God to be heard (13:3a)

皆因我們未將萬事，帶到主恩座前求。

2. 大衛祈求使他的眼睛明亮(13:3下)

2. David asks specifically for
enlightenment (13:3b)

恩友歌（第二節）

或遇試煉或遇引誘，或有煩惱壓心頭；
切莫灰心切莫喪膽，來到主恩座前求。
何處得此忠心朋友，分擔一切苦與憂，
耶穌深知我們軟弱，來到主恩座前求。

3. 大衛特意祈求免得他的仇敵得勝
(13:4)

3. David asks specifically for
victory from his enemy (13:4)

恩友歌（第三節）

是否軟弱勞苦多愁，掛慮重擔壓肩頭；
主仍是我避難處所，來到主恩座前求。
親或離我友或棄我，來到主恩座前求，
在主懷中必蒙護佑，與主同在永無憂。

C. 歡欣的呼喊(13:5-6)

⁵至於我，我倚靠你的慈愛，我的心必因你的救恩歡呼。⁶我要歌頌耶和華，因他以厚恩待我。

C. A Cry of Rejoicing knowledge (13:5-6)

5 But I have trusted in Your mercy; My heart shall rejoice in Your salvation.

6 I will sing to the Lord, Because He has dealt bountifully with me.

2. 大衛在主裡重新得著歡欣 (13:5下)

2. David rejoices in the Lord again (13:5b)

3. 大衛重新歌頌上帝 (13:6)
